

MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JANUARY

The January Class III price decreased \$1.07 from the previous month to \$16.27. The Class II price for January of \$17.14 per hundredweight decreased 80 cents from \$16.34 in December. January's Class III-A price decreased 36 cents from December's level to \$13.12.

Texas: Producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Zones 1 and 2 of the Texas Milk Market Order received \$18.03 per hundredweight for deliveries of milk containing 3.5% butterfat. The January price was up 18 cents from December.

Producers delivered a total of 586,568,030 pounds of milk during January. On a daily basis this represents an increase of 32.36 percent from the producer receipts level in December and it represents an increase of 19.47 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of January 1998.


Producer milk classified as Class I during January amounted to 48.12 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is down from December's 62.18 percent and it is

down from 57.42 percent in January 1998. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during January 1999 was 3.659 percent.

New Mexico - West Texas: Producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Zone 1 of the New Mexico - West Texas Milk Market Order received \$16.68 per hundredweight for deliveries of milk containing 3.5% butterfat. The January price was down 40 cents from its December level.


Producers delivered a total of 166,744,777 pounds of milk during January. On a daily basis this represents an increase of 90.43 percent from the producer receipts level in December but it represents a decrease of 20.84 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of January 1998.

Producer milk classified as Class I during January amounted to 32.76 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is down from 61.23 percent in December but it is up from 26.51 percent in January 1998. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during January 1999 was 3.674 percent.





