MARKET SUMMARY FOR JULY

The Producer Price Differential (P.P.D.) for milk delivered to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) of the Southwest Milk Market Order was \$1.09 for July. Butterfat price increased \$0.2075 per pound from \$1.5932 in June to the level of \$1.8007 in July. Protein price decreased \$0.1183 per pound from \$2.5741 in June to \$2.4558 in July. July's Other Solids price increased \$0.0101 per pound from \$0.1139 in June to \$0.1240 in July. The Somatic Cell Count adjustment rate factor for July was .00076 per thousand (difference from 350).


For comparison in hundredweights, producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) received a July statistical uniform price of \$15.44 per hundredweight for milk testing 3.5% butterfat, 2.99% true protein, 5.69% other solids and 350,000 SCC. This is an increase of \$0.57 in comparison to the statistical blend price of \$14.87 in June.


The July Class I price increased \$0.27 from \$16.62 in June to the July level of \$16.89. The Class II price for July of \$13.79 per hundredweight increased \$0.73 from \$13.06 in June. July's Class III price increased \$0.43 from \$13.92 in June to \$14.35 in July. The Class IV price increased \$0.84 from \$12.33 in June to \$13.17 in July.

In July 825 producers delivered a total of 892,829,675 pounds of milk. On a daily basis this represents an increase of 2.79 percent from the producer receipts level in June and it represents an increase of 2.04 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of July 2004.

Producer milk classified as Class I during July amounted to 35.83 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is down from 37.35 percent in June and it is down from 37.56 percent in July 2004. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during July was 3.518 percent, average protein test was 2.926 percent, average other solids test was 5.728 percent and the average somatic cell count was 295,000.




