MARKET SUMMARIES FOR AUGUST

The August Class III price increased 22 cents from the previous month to \$14.99. The Class II price for August of \$13.40 per hundredweight increased \$2.22 from \$11.18 in July. August's Class III-A price increased 93 cents from July's level to \$16.52.

Texas: Producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Zones 1 and 2 of the Texas Milk Market Order received \$15.50 per hundredweight for deliveries of milk containing 3.5% butterfat. The August price was up \$2.28 from July.

Producers delivered a total of 381,169,860 pounds of milk during August. On a daily basis this represents a decrease of 2.29 percent from the producer receipts level in July and it represents a decrease of 13.80 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of August 1997.

Producer milk classified as Class I during August amounted to 72.11 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is up from July's 68.78 percent and it is up

from 62.07 percent in August 1997. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during August 1998 was 3.44 percent.


New Mexico - West Texas: Producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Zone 1 of the New Mexico - West Texas Milk Market Order received \$15.05 per hundredweight for deliveries of milk containing 3.5% butterfat. The August price was up \$2.01 from its July level.

Producers delivered a total of 107,254,927 pounds of milk during August. On a daily basis this represents an increase of 70.07 percent from the producer receipts level in July but it represents a decrease of 36.53 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of August 1997.

Producer milk classified as Class I during August amounted to 50.12 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is down from 81.48 percent in July but it is up from 32.15 percent in August 1997. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during August 1998 was 3.350 percent.


