

#### SOUTHWEST MARKETING AREA

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#### MARKET SUMMARY FOR APRIL

The Producer Price Differential (P.P.D.) for milk delivered to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) of the Southwest Milk Market Order was \$2.85 for April. Butterfat price increased \$0.2663 per pound from \$1.6820 in March to the level of \$1.9483 for April. Protein price decreased \$0.1055 cents per pound from \$1.6498 in March to \$1.5443 in April. April's Other Solids price increased \$0.0042 per pound from the previous month to \$0.1081. The Somatic Cell Count adjustment rate factor for April was .00067 per thousand (difference from 350).


For comparison in hundredweights, producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) received a April statistical uniform price of \$14.91 per hundredweight for milk testing 3.5% butterfat, 2.99% true protein, 5.69% other solids and 350,000 SCC. This is an increase of 73 cents in comparison to the statistical blend price of \$14.18 in March.


The April Class I price increased 79 cents from \$15.65 in March to the April level of \$16.44. The Class II price for April of \$15.10 per hundredweight increased 93 cents from \$14.17 in March. April's Class III price increased 64 cents from \$11.42 in March to \$12.06 in April. The Class IV price increased 95 cents from \$13.46 in March to \$14.41 in April.

In April 784 producers delivered a total of 681,005,665 pounds of milk. On a daily basis this represents an increase of 3.07 percent from the producer receipts level in March but it represents a decrease of 8.25 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of April 2000.

Producer milk classified as Class I during April amounted to 47.38 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is down from 50.87 percent in March but it is up from 42.20 percent in April 2000. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during April was 3.550 percent, average protein test was 3.028 percent, average other solids test was 5.685 percent and the average somatic cell count was 345,000.




