

#### SOUTHWEST MARKETING AREA

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#### MARKET SUMMARY FOR JULY

The Producer Price Differential (P.P.D.) for milk delivered to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) of the Southwest Milk Market Order was \$2.23 for June. Butterfat price decreased \$0.1225 per pound from \$2.1768 in June to the level of \$2.0543 in July. Protein price decreased \$0.7461 per pound from \$3.1068 in June to \$2.3625 in July. July's Other Solids price decreased \$0.0291 per pound from \$0.1339 in June to \$0.1048 in July. The Somatic Cell Count adjustment rate factor for July was .00078 per thousand (difference from 350).


For comparison in hundredweights, producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) received a July statistical uniform price of \$17.08 per hundredweight for milk testing 3.5% butterfat, 2.99% true protein, 5.69% other solids and 350,000 SCC. This is a decrease of \$2.32 in comparison to the statistical blend price of \$19.04 in June.


The July Class I price decreased \$3.18 from \$24.13 in June to the July level of \$20.95. The Class II price for July of \$14.00 per hundredweight decreased \$0.31 from \$14.31 in June. July's Class III price decreased \$2.83 from \$17.68 in June to \$14.85 in July. The Class IV price decreased \$0.41 from \$13.72 in June to \$13.31 in July.

In July 954 producers delivered a total of 874,968,284 pounds of milk. On a daily basis this represents an increase of 8.85 percent from the producer receipts level in June and it represents an increase of 46.96 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of July 2003.

Producer milk classified as Class I during July amounted to 37.56 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is down from 40.37 percent in June and it is down from 54.61 percent in July 2003. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during July was 3.512 percent, average protein test was 2.956 percent, average other solids test was 5.718 percent and the average somatic cell count was 324,000.




