

MARKET SUMMARY FOR DECEMBER

The Producer Price Differential (P.P.D.) for milk delivered to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) of the Southwest Milk Market Order was \$0.41 for December. Butterfat price increased \$0.0271 per pound from \$1.4077 in November to the level of \$1.4348 in December. Protein price increased \$0.3980 per pound from \$4.3081 in November to \$4.7061 in December. December's Other Solids price increased \$0.0176 per pound from \$0.2461 in November to \$0.2637 in December. The Somatic Cell Count adjustment rate factor for December was 0.00105 per thousand (difference from 350).

For comparison in hundredweights, producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) received a December statistical uniform price of \$21.01 per hundredweight for milk testing 3.5% butterfat, 2.99% true protein, 5.69% other solids and 350,000 SCC. This is a decrease of \$0.51 in comparison to the statistical blend price of \$21.58 in November.


The December Class I price decreased \$1.41 from \$24.45 in November to the December level of \$23.04. The Class II price for December of \$20.82 per hundredweight decreased \$1.25 from \$22.07 in November. December's Class III price increased \$1.38 from \$19.22 in November to \$20.60 in December. The Class IV price decreased \$1.22 from \$20.40 in November to \$19.18 in December.

In December 781 producers delivered a total of 639,380,809 pounds of milk. On a daily basis this represents a decrease of 32.98 percent from the producer receipts level in November and it represents a decrease of 40.64 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of December 2006.

Producer milk classified as Class I during December amounted to 54.15 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is up from 38.40 percent in November and it is up from 32.53 percent in December 2006. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during December was 3.824 percent, average protein test was 3.196 percent, average other solids test was 5.699 percent and the average somatic cell count was 261,000.




