MARKET SUMMARY FOR JUNE

The Producer Price Differential (PPD) for milk delivered to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) of the Southwest Milk Market Order was \$1.91 for June. Butterfat price increased \$0.1692 per pound from \$2.2721 in May to the level of \$2.4413 in June. Protein price decreased \$0.6116 per pound from \$3.9553 in May to \$3.3437 in June. The Other Solids price increased \$0.0045 per pound from \$.4897 in May to \$0.4942 in June. The Somatic Cell Count adjustment rate factor for June was 0.00102 per thousand (difference from 350).

For comparison in hundredweights, producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) received a June statistical uniform price of \$23.27 per hundredweight for milk testing 3.5% butterfat, 2.99% true protein, 5.69% other solids and 350,000 SCC. This is an decrease of \$1.16 in comparison to the statistical uniform price of \$24.43 in May.

The June Class I price decreased \$1.61 from \$27.47

in May to the June level of \$25.86. The Class II price decreased \$0.50 from \$24.44 per hundredweight in May to \$ 23.94 in June. The Class III price decreased \$1.21 from \$22.57 in May to \$21.36 in June. The Class IV price increased \$0.48 from \$22.65 in May to \$23.13 in June.

In June 548 producers delivered a total of 1,098,747,962 pounds of milk. On a daily basis this represents a decrease of 9.18 percent from the producer receipts level in May and it represents an increase of 13.08 percent when compared to the producer receipts level of June 2013.

Producer milk classified as Class I during June amounted to 28.58 percent of total producer receipts. This figure is down from 29.06 percent in May and is down from 31.84 percent in June 2013. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during June was 3.532 percent, average protein test was 3.065 percent, average other solids test was 5.788 percent and the average somatic cell count was 197,000.




