

Market Administrator's Report Southwest Marketing Area Federal Order 126

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MARKET SUMMARY FOR NOVEMBER

The Producer Price Differential (PPD) for milk delivered to handlers located in Dallas/Tarrant counties (TX) of the Southwest Milk Market Order was \$1.63 for November. Butterfat price increased \$0.0166 per pound from \$2.5551 in October to the level of \$2.5385 in November. Protein price decreased \$0.3766 per pound from \$1.7185 in October to \$1.3419 in November. The Other Solids price increased \$0.0161 per pound from \$0.2553 in October to \$0.2714 in November. The Somatic Cell Count Adjustment rate factor for November was 0.00072 per thousand (difference from 350).

For comparison in hundredweights, producers who delivered milk to handlers located in Dallas/ Tarrant counties (TX) received a November statistical uniform price of \$16.07 for milk testing 3.5% butterfat, 2.99% true protein, 5.69% other solids and 350,000 SCC. This is decrease of \$0.79 in comparison to the statistical uniform price of \$16.86 in October.

The November Class I price decreased \$0.81 from \$19.33 in October to the November level of \$18.52. The Class II price increased \$0.09 from \$15.54 in October to \$15.63 in November. The Class III price decreased \$1.09 from \$15.53 in October to \$14.44 in November. The Class IV price increased \$0.05 from \$15.01 in October to \$15.06 in November.

In November, 481 producers delivered a total of 1,249,530,018 pounds of milk. On a daily basis, this represents a decrease of 2.54% from the producer receipts level in October and it represents an increase of 79.91% when compared to the producer receipts level of November 2017.

Producer milk classified as Class I during November amounted to 29.99% of total producer receipts. This figure is up from 28.98% in October and is down from 53.82% in November 2017. The average butterfat test of producer milk pooled during November was 4.120%, average protein test was 3.362%, average other solids test was 5.765% and the average somatic cell count was 231,000.





DAIRY AMERICA SETTLEMENT INFORMATION

After obtaining approval from handlers to release their data, USDA provided Rust Consulting with the producer pounds of milk pooled on FMMO's that was available during the settlement period, January 2002 through April 2007. As instructed on the claim forms that producers have begun receiving, if producers have records indicating a different amount of pooled pounds, copies of those documents can be provided to Rust Consulting. In either case, producers are reminded that signed claimed forms must be postmarked by January 28, 2019. October Agricultural Prices Highlights

The All Milk price received by farmers was \$17.40 in October, down \$.70 from October 2017. Milk Cows price was \$1,230 in October, down \$380 from October 2017. Alfalfa hay price was \$178.00 in October, up \$25.00 from October 2017. Com price was \$3.41 in October, up \$.15 from October 2017. Soybea price was \$8.58 in October, down \$.60 from October 2017. The milk-feed price ratio was 2.20 in October, down 0.27 from October 2017.

The index of prices received by farmers for dairy products during the month of October 2018 was up 3.5 to 86.6. Compared to October 2017, the index wa down 3.4 points (-3.8 percent). The index of prices paid by farmers for commodities and services, interest, taxes, and wage rates in October 2018 was up 0.5 t 109.4. Compared with October 2017, the index was up 2.6 points (+2.4 percent).

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
October Milk Production

Milk production in the 23 major States during October totaled 16.9 billion pounds, up 1.0 percent from October 2017. September revised production, at 16.4 billion pounds, was up 1.5 percent from September 2017. The September revision represented a decrease of 2 million pounds or less than 0.1 percent from last month's preliminary production estimate.

Production per cow in the 23 major States averaged 1,934 pounds for October, 20 pounds above October 2017. This is the highest production per cow for the month of October since the 23 State series began in 2003.

The number of milk cows on farms in the 23 major States was 8.72 million head, 8,000 head less than October 2017, and 1,000 head less than September 2018.
